

Top eSnipe Tools to Use When You Snipe on eBay

The tools we review here have proven success for when you want to snipe on eBay. Some are more user friendly than others. Some are free, some are not.

Not everything that you pay for is a good product, and definitely not everything that's free is bad. When it comes to online auction tools, the old adage that says “You get what you pay for” is definitely not always accurate.

So without further a due, let's get to the nitty-gritty on what sniping tools and services are the best to use when you snipe on eBay.

The Sniper Line-up

There is a whole slew of auction sniper tools that you can use to snipe on eBay. There are sniping service companies that allow other companies to make their own sniping tools and use their service as the “back-end”. So what you end up with is a sniping tool on top of a sniping tool.

WOOO HOOO!

Okay. Now, don't stress out about what I just said, all you need to remember is that there is a ton of choices when it comes to sniping tools to use to snipe on eBay.

So you may ask, “How in the world do I choose a good snipe tool?”

Good question.

Let's take a step back for a moment and not get caught up in the number of tools that you have to choose from.

Instead, let's focus on the most popular sniping service providers.

The eSnipe Measuring Stick

Before we review the esnipe services, here are the requirements and features we based our reviews off of:

- Supports Bid Groups
- You can bid on an auction item from the item web page so you don't have to open other windows, copy auction item number, or any other complicated auction dance just to snipe on

eBay.

- Supports Search Capabilities so the search & bid process is simplified
- Price Comparison with competitors
- Free trial offered
- Supports eBay Motors
- Supports all eBay regions
- Support Multiple Currencies on eBay
- Ease of Navigation for the esnipe service
- Ability to import your eBay watch list
- Ability to manage and organize your bids

How the eSnipe Services Measure Up

[AuctionSniper.com](#)

- Web interface is a little awkward to move around in.
- Supports bid groups
- Pricing is good. Pay as you go. Only 1% of final auction . Minimum of \$0.25. Maximum of \$9.95.
- You can earn free snipes. Every person you refer provides you with 3 free snipes.
- Import item from eBay watch list
- Snipe It Now link on toolbar so you can snipe from any item view page on eBay.
- Can't cancel your bid if the time left of the auction is less than 5 minutes!
- Search Features included. Advanced search features are awkward to get to.
- Supports all eBay regions and currencies

[AuctionStealer.com](#)

- Browsing can be challenging
- With free service, you cannot snipe on eBay less than 10 seconds before the auction close.
- FREE – cannot use Snipe It! Tool from your browser's toolbar.
- With Priority service, you can specify as little as 3 seconds before the auction end.

- Service fees are rather high, ranging from around \$70 to \$90 year. However, you do get unlimited snipes.
- Can use bid groups with Priority service and are easy to manage.
- Free – 97% bids placed successfully
- Priority Service – 99.9% bids placed successfully
- Search ability is provided through an alternate website.
- Very limited way to manage and organize your auctions.
- One of the more frustrating to deal with sniping services.
- Does not appear to support eBay Motors
- Does not appear to support non-US auctions & currencies
- You cannot import your current watch list.

[BidNip.com](#)

- Prices seem very fair. They range from Free for your 1st 5 snipes to \$39.95 for 250 successful snipes. You do not pay if you do not win.
- Doesn't offer the use of bid groups
- Search functions are very mediocre at best. We had problems getting the search feature to work at all.
- Very limited way to manage and organize your auctions.
- Supports all eBay currencies & regions.
- Supports eBay Motors
- You cannot import your current eBay watch list.
- May be a good service to use if all you want is a very basic service to use to snipe on eBay.
- You can snipe on eBay from the item auction page.

[BidSlammer.com](#)

- Supports bid groups
- The site is very easy navigation after you log on.
- Prices are very fair. You pay 1% of the final auction amount but no more than \$5.
- Have the ability to snipe on eBay from the item page by using their SlamIt! Feature.
- Free Trial service offered.
- 99.98% bids placed successfully.
- Supports all eBay regions and sites
- Support eBay Motors
- No way, apart from bid groups, to manage & organize your bids.
- You cannot import your current eBay watch list.
- Very mediocre search features are offered, however, even those features cost you between \$0.05 to \$0.50 per day to use.

ESnipe.com

- Supports bid groups
- You can very easily organize your current and past bids into separate folders.
- You pay only if you win. The pricing is fair. \$0.25 for items up to \$24.99. 1% on items \$25 - \$1,000. \$1,000 or greater, a maximum of a \$10 fee.
- Esnipe supports all currencies used on eBay.
- Esnipe support all eBay regions.
- Supports eBay Motors
- Support for Yahoo esnipes is currently under development.
- You can snipe on eBay auction item page.
- Does not provide any search features.
- Cannot import your current eBay watch list

EZSniper.com

- Provides an ability to search only through a partner service.
- Does not support bid groups.
- Prices are average. 1% of final auction price. Minimum of \$0.10 and a maximum of \$10.
- No way to manage & organize your bids
- Supports the ability to snipe on eBay directly from the auction item page.
- Very poor navigation and bidding process.
- Supports all eBay currencies
- Support all eBay regions
- Support eBay Motors

MoxieProxy.com

- Supports the use of bid groups
- Very high quality search tool included with Prospector.
- Searches can be automated.
- Provides a way to organize your auction searches just about any way your heart desires.
- Supports all eBay regions
- Supports all eBay currencies
- Supports eBay Motors
- Can bid or snipe on eBay from the auction item web page.
- Pricing is far superior to other esnipe services. Prices range from FREE to a one time cost of \$69, depending on your auction searching/bidding needs. There are no annual or renewable costs associated with Prospector.
- Software is downloaded to your PC.
- Does not allow you to bid away from your PC.

- Support for other auction sites are currently under development.
- The ability to snipe from your WAP enabled cell phone is currently being developed.

PowerSnipe.com

- Allows bid groups
- Prices are a yearly flat rate and are competitive with other esnipe services. The costs are \$45.99 per year.
- 30-Day money back guarantee offered.
- Very easy navigation
- Can snipe both via their website and via Powersnipe software on your computer if you want to snipe on eBay.
- Software download available for bidding and for searching. You can thereby show and bid anywhere there is a computer, and get more advanced tools when you're sitting in front of your PC at home.
- Can snipe on eBay directly from the auction item page.
- Limited way to manage & organize your auction bids.
- Highly rated by auction users
- All eBay currencies are supported.
- All eBay regions are supported
- Supports eBay Motors

The eSnipe Winners Are...

If you want to snipe on eBay, MoxieProxy.com comes in a strong first place. Their tool, Prospector Lite, has a very high quality search tool for being able to get those hard-to-find auctions.

The software to snipe on eBay is built into Prospector Lite. Of all the tools reviewed, it had the most valuable features at the best price...FREE!

You get all of the most valuable esnipe features without having to pay the "most valuable" price! The only downfall to the tool is that it has to be installed on your computer if you want to snipe on eBay.

For most people, this is not an issue as they do the vast majority of their bidding while they are at home.
